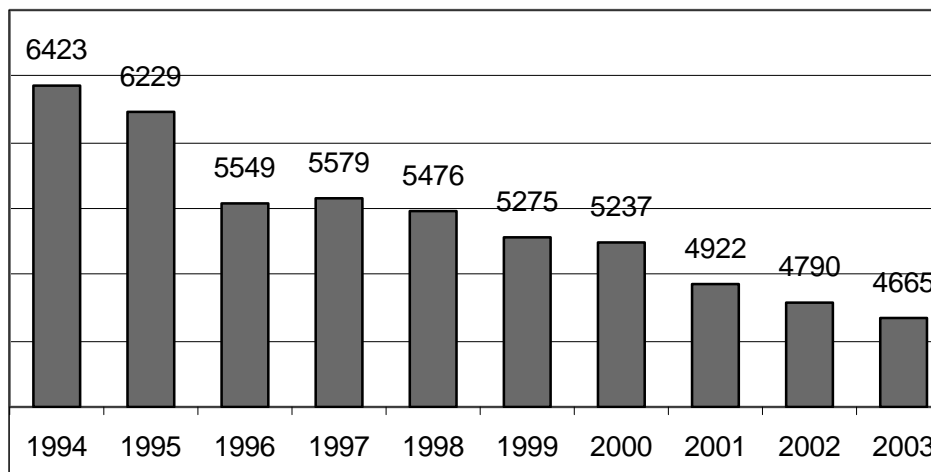

- 14.8 % / 1998

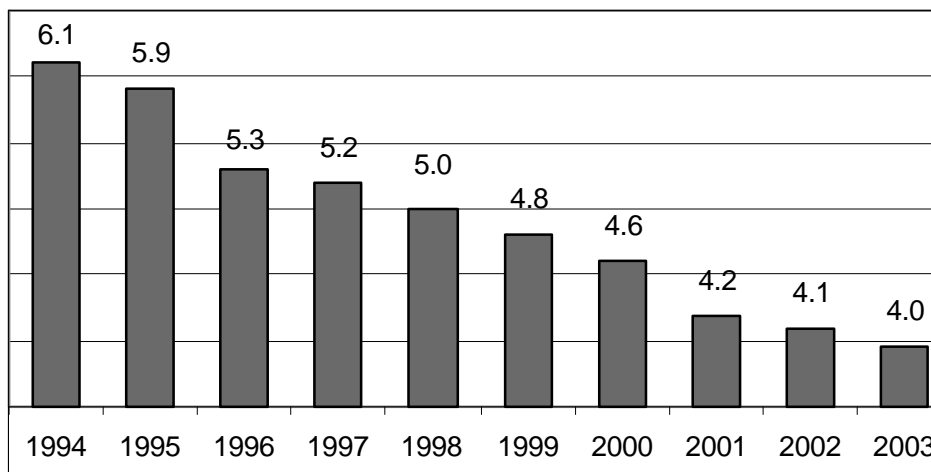

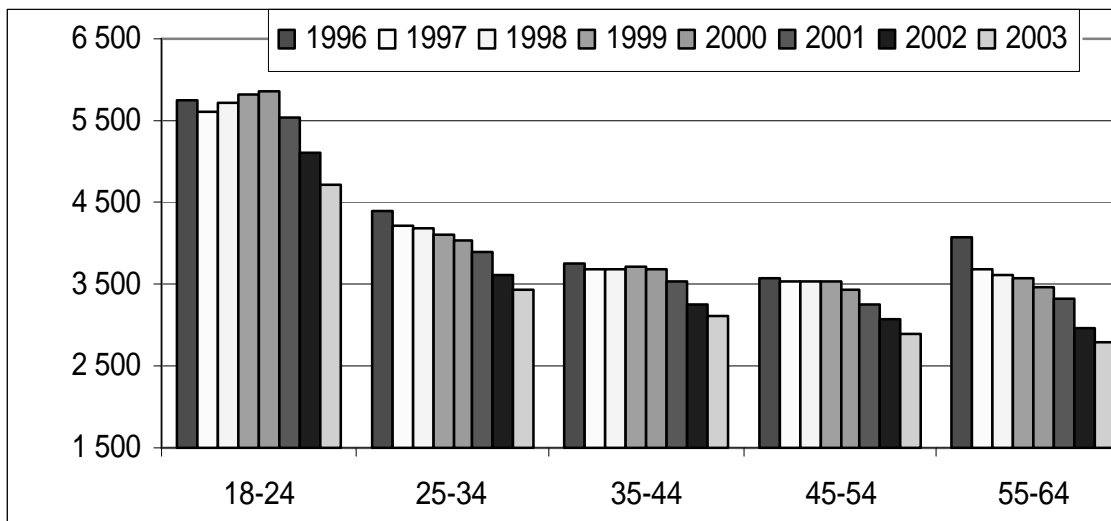

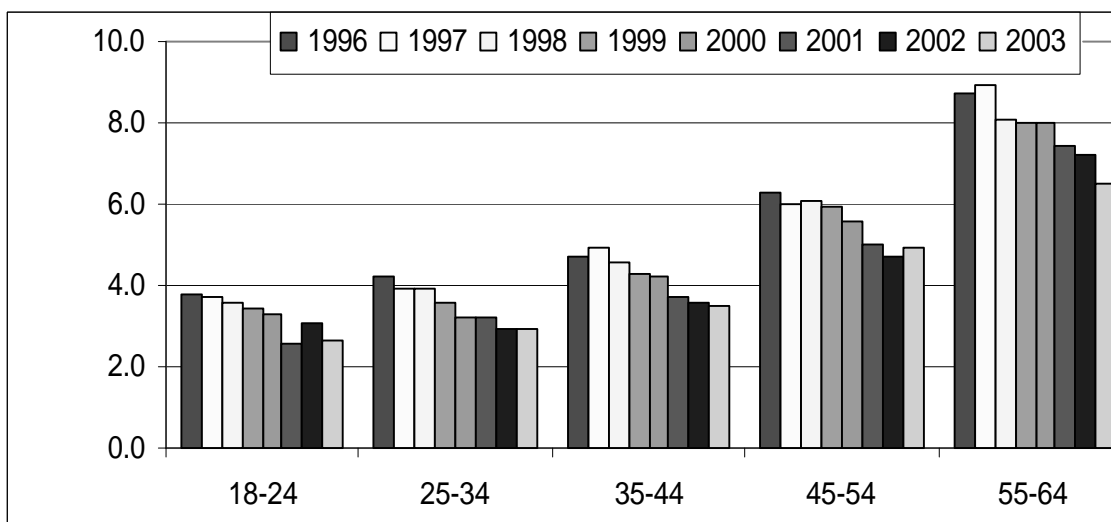

Accidents with more 3 day's absence

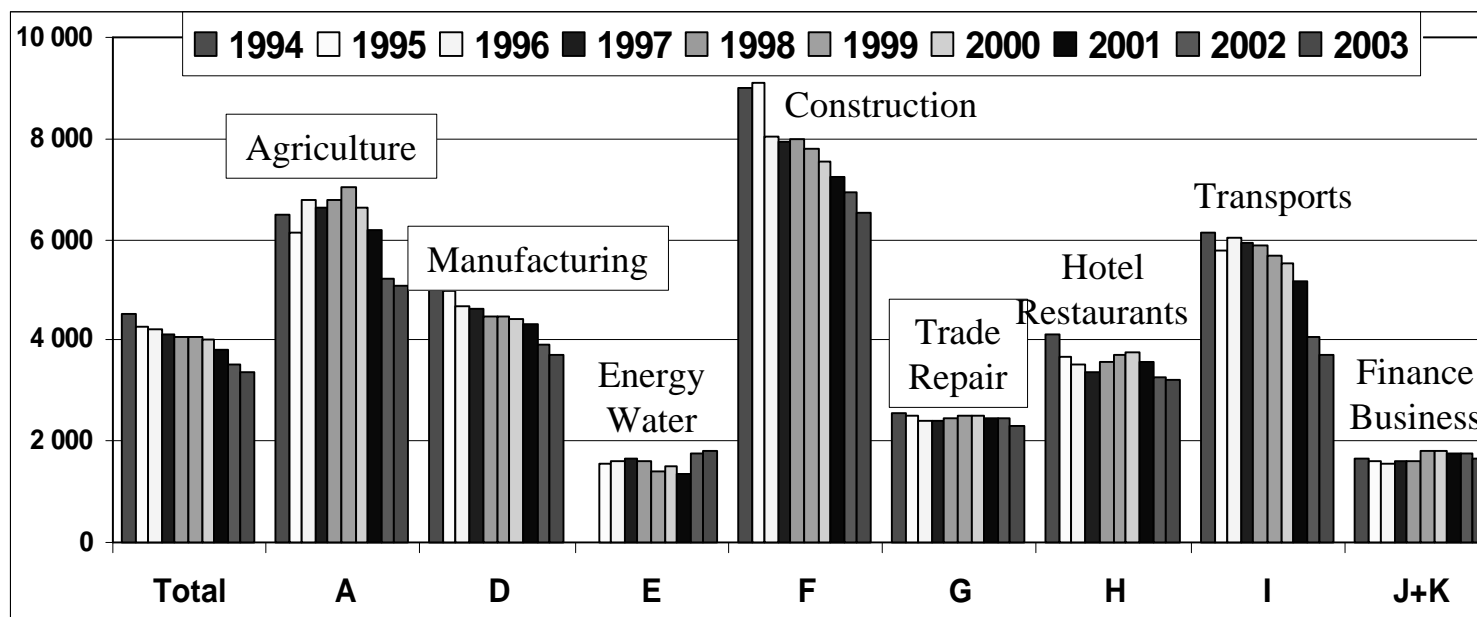


Fatal accidents



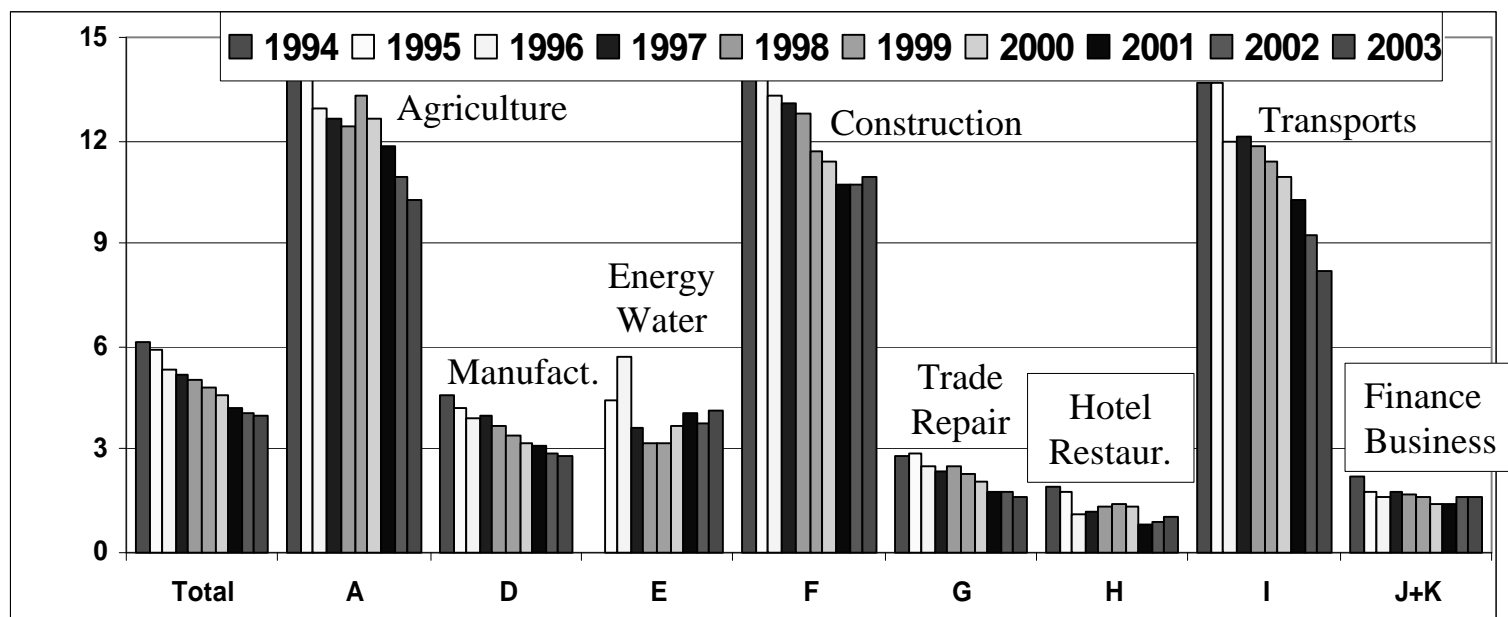
